Canine Schedule

Canine schedule highly recommended, **Core Vaccines are shown in **Maroon**.**

6 weeks:

Corona/Parvo Combination Vaccine

8 weeks:

Distemper/Adeno/Lepto/Parainfluenza + Corona ("DA2LPP+C")

12 weeks:

DA2LPP+C

Rabies Vaccine

Kennel Cough Complex (injection)

Lyme Disease

16 weeks:

DA2LPP+C

Kennel Cough Complex (intranasal)

Rabies

6 - 12 months:

Kennel Cough Complex (booster)

Annually Rabies Vaccine (booster)

Vaccination against Giarrdia is recommended for dogs having poor immune

systems, if exposure is likely (call or stop by to find out how your animal can

be exposed).

Vaccinations for ringworm are only occasionally used when an animal is not responding to normal treatment.
